W4	Grenache Gris 'Le Pal', Boulevard Napoléon, 2015 <i>One of the best examples of white wines from the Languedoc region. Aromatic, with citrus perfumes, this wine is rich and supple on the palate with distinct notes of smoke and liquorice. The finish is fresh, long and lingering.</i>	59.00
